CONTACT OUR EVENT MANAGER

> Contact our Event Manager to place a tentative hold on a date. The Event Manager will then forward you a copy of the contract. When it is signed and returned with the required deposit your date will be secure.



TOURNAMENT MENU

> Attached is a copy of our tournament menu. Final selections and quantities must be confirmed 7 days ahead of your tournament.



FORMAT OF PLAY

> Our Head Professional can assist you in establishing the appropriate format of play for your event. Scramble format is usually recommended as it speeds up the game and allows golfers of all abilities to share in the day's excitement. The Pro Shop will tabulate scores and post results.



SIGNAGE : CONTESTS AND SPONSORS

> Our most common tournament contests are Closest to the Pin, Long Drive, Beat-the-Pro and Hole In One. The Event Manager can suggest the appropriate hole for each contest you select. If you supply Sponsor-signs, our staff will arrange for their placement on the tees.

Policies & Procedures



ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

> The Richmond Hill Golf Club is licensed by the LLBO to provide all alcoholic beverages on the course and in the clubhouse area. Your guests are not permitted to bring or consume personal supplies on the property. Failure to comply may result in cancellation of their play and/or removal from the property. All employees are Smart Serve trained and have the right to refuse service to anyone who appears to be intoxicated.

DRESS CODE

Not Permitted:

- > Blue Jeans
- > T-Shirts or Tank Tops
- > Tracksuits or gym outfits
- > Hard spiked shoes

POWER CARTS

> Power Carts must be operated in a safe manner obeying all signs, safety rules & regulations. The driver must hold a valid drivers license. Under no circumstance are juniors permitted to drive a power cart. Carts are permitted in the parking lot and must be driven in a safe manner. All carts are to be returned to the designated cart return area.

SLOW PLAY

> Slow play is everyone's concern and we appreciate your full support and co-operation in maintaining a proper pace for your event. Our Play Coordinators will help golfers keep pace and have full authority instruct slow players to skip holes or abandon hunts for lost balls.

LOCAL RULES

- > Free drop from all paths and staked trees;
Drop 1 club length closest relief no nearer the hole
- > Hole #1 & #2 - Free drop away from range netting if interfering with stance or swing
- > Hole #11 & #18 - use Drop Area if tee shot lands in lateral hazard on the left or right side.

- > Tournament organizers agree to incrementally pay or reimburse Richmond Hill Golf Club for all charges pertaining to damage their guests may cause on, or to, the club's property and equipment including power carts and rental clubs.

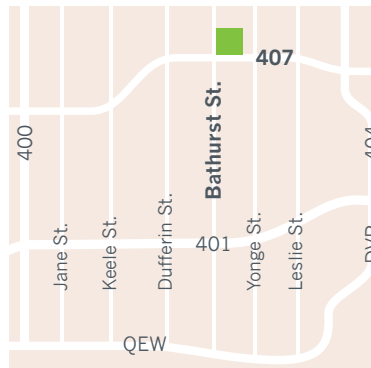
